- If all money not spent, rolls over if requested (new policy). AMS accounts have residual money and nothing has been done, so our budget never lines up. Would be a ton of work to reconcile and this year might not be ideal because COVID.
- With BLSA are not part of LSS clubs because they put a lot of work in but get little benefit (with so few members). Might want to do an affiliation.
- Does not being able to do things in person change the strategy for funding? Funding comes from student fees and those aren't being reduced. Wouldn't save money from not giving it out. Lots of clubs are still trying to do virtual events and such. Giving them money this year benefits them for the following year because of roll over.
