	concerns that Navid has been working on. Kiera and Liz have been talking		
	about creating a code of conduct to talk to Dean as well. If anyone has		
	anything they want to bring to Dean, let Kiera know.		

- Re code of conduct: for interacting online. Need a process for how to deal with online interactions. Orientation girls are doing canvas module on respect in online space.
- Navid attended president's council in Kiera's place (president's council is a council for club presidents to seek mutual aid and support). Nest opened in May. AMS is reopening slowly and working on plan for September. Everyone is having issues with UBC Admin not enough info. Questions about student fees a majority of our student fees goes to the CSO. We get about \$30-40. There is chat about reducing fees/subsidies. Not something that has been in question yet for Law, but may be a thing to chat about with COVID. Some buildings have been focusing on capital projects since buildings are empty. Can lower without a referendum but not raise. Goes to Board of Directors of AMS. Would be a problem to bring them back up later because of referendum. CSO is doing more than ever now. Funding rolls over (we get it in surplus account). Need to be wary of clubs because of new rule that they get less funding if they don't use it all don't want them to spend less. Christa had idea to do general clubs fundraiser and distribute to those who need it.

#### Finances:

- May be worth looking into getting Zoom funding from AMS
- Kelsey and Rasheed are scheduling transition for next week
- Kelsey is having AMS orientation
- Reimbursements are usually with cash, but it will be e-transfers for now (unless over \$500)
- Kelsey and Kiera need to get authorized
- Question on budget: surplus or deficit? Once authorized, Kelsey can see overall picture but not all line items because it is on computer in AMS.
- Firms have asked Liz about money they sent us that was not used. Some want it to be returned, some say to roll it over. Kelsey will know more after meeting with Rasheed.
- Ask AMS what to do about reimbursement to be picked up when it was still cash. It was processed before e transfer system so people can't get refunds. Kelsey will look into this.

## Academic:

- Putting together document of concerns to bring to Dean especially COVID and online classes
- Hoping to do student consultation on curriculum changes
- Making a terms of reference for Academic committee
- Looking at website would be nice to have an online repository for year to year handover
- On transfers: Kiera will follow up with transition memos if you haven't received yours
- Looking at amending faculty council on rules about who sits on what committees and ensure that ILSA has positions on relevant committees

- Concerns over online classes. Uteck was interested in this topic and wanted to hear more. Cassandra will continue to meet with her.
- Wants to do survey about student experience with COVID Communications:
- Need to update name change on all LSS platforms
- Social media strategy would be good to look into coming up with strategies for different platforms
- Meeting minutes online need to be updated Johanna has to look into tracking down ones from past years
- Re domain name we already own ubclss.com once we pay for the year, we can update to park allardlsss.com
- Keep system of using survey to collect names and emails. Potentially could add to Christa's survey but through orientation is more encompassing.

#### Clubs:

- Christa sending survey over Facebook about club participation this year

#### Senator:

- Natasha was in meeting with Provost and got draft of document being sent to Deans with thoughts about moving to online teaching. Has lots of good principles, but concerns over what will happen when profs don't follow them. Question of how to ensure profs are implementing these rules. Maybe bring back mid-term evaluations.
- Potentially want to look at if we get feedback in September and bring to faculty council.
- Should decide what role we are going to take
- Maybe Joanna can make it clear that she is an ear for these types of complaints.
